

## **PARKS MEETING NOTES JANUARY 12<sup>TH</sup> 2022 9:30 AM**

### **ZOOM**

*The meeting was called to order by Ollie Iversen at 9:30 am with Martin Howard, Ken Lee and Ollie Iversen present for a quorum. Also at the meeting were Scott Thomas, Town Administrator, and Mary Wohleb Town Councilperson.*

### **Old Business**

- A. *Maple Park Survey Results-Mary Wohleb, after sharing the survey results with the Town Council, posted them on the Town's website under Parks. It has all the survey information received for review and use, for future Maple Park planning. Scott Thomas has looked into the grant process for this park and will include it with other grants projects Town is working on.*
- B. *Fill Annie Taylor's empty seat-Ollie reported he had spoken to a possible Parks candidate, and he was invited to this meeting. Ollie then opened the discussion and Ken Lee said he had spoken to B.J. Carol about the open seat, and she was very interested. Ollie will reach out to her and with her permission, put in her name for this position.*
- C. *Conner Waterfront Park water fountain is funded-After reviewing two different styles of fountains, one more contemporary, versus the other with a traditional look. No decision came out of this. Ollie will get with Public Works and come up with several sites near a water line, and ADA tables. After finding the sites, we should walk them to finalize placement. We should vote on this next month.*
- D. *Skateboard Park Graffiti-It was reported Public Works knows what it can do to remove the final bit of graffiti from the concrete and will need dry weather to do this, which means next spring.*
- E. *Kiosks-After surveying all the kiosks after the one that fell over, it brought up the fact that all the kiosks need cleaning, repainting, and re-signing. As there is no budget to do them all, at this time, Mary brought forward that Public Works could repair the fallen kiosk only and place it on its original site. Ollie will speak with Public Works and see if and when this could be done. To fix it will require the purchase of steel for a new base which also would require welding. Bill Stokes said he would be happy to do the welding on this. To refurbish all the kiosks, will require somewhere around \$8,000 to \$10,000, and this should be placed in next year's budget.*
