### ONGOING PROJECTS REVIEW

Fun Raiser Results—Ollie reports that we have fully funded the proposed Picnic Shelter. This is a 12 x 20 log style building placed on a new slab a couple of feet south of the existing western ADA picnic table on the water side of the walkway leading to the King Salmon Slide. A short new cement path will provide ADA access into it. The structure will provide shelter from rain and sun, and be open on all sides. There was discussion about the possibility of enlarging it to 18 x 24 (?), but this would need more funding. The Commissioners agreed that the priority is to get it built with the present plan.

Waterfront Park Schedule-

Bank Stabilization Project should be starting during the “fish window” in August 2019.
