AMENDMENT TO THE INTERLOCAL AGREEMENT  
FOR

THE ADMINISTRATION AND INVESTIGATION OF THE WASHINGTON STATE  
BUILDING CODE AND RELATED CONSTRUCTION CODES

WHEREAS, this is an amendment to Interlocal Agreement No. 002466 entered into this 11<sup>th</sup> day of March, 1996, for the administration and investigation of the Washington State Building Code and related codes entered into the 22nd day of May, 1995, by and between Skagit County, Washington, a political subdivision of the State of Washington (County) and the Town of La Conner (Town).

THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that the following changes and amendments be made as follows:

1. Add to Item No. 2 - Because Fire Marshal services are not paid for out of permit fees in Skagit County, a separate fee schedule (Exhibit No. 1) included in this amendment shall be used for Fire Marshal services. These fees shall be added to the fees charged for permits. These fees shall be collected by the Permit Center.
2. Amend the last sentence of Item No. 2 to read: Fire code inspections on new construction shall be provided by the Skagit County Fire Marshal's Office. Fireworks and Burning Permits shall remain the responsibility of the Town. Determination of required fire flows shall be guided by Table IIIA of the Uniform Fire Code (UFC) and determined by the Skagit County Fire Marshal in conjunction with the Town Fire Chief.
3. Add the following to Item No. 9: Fire Marshal services shall be effective from the 11<sup>th</sup> day of March, 1996, and shall continue unless terminated pursuant to Section 10 of the above named agreement.
