**A RESOLUTION OF THE TOWN OF LA CONNER TO CELEBRATE
THE YEAR OF THE BIRD**

WHEREAS, La Conner is located in a magnificent birding location; and

WHEREAS, La Conner benefits greatly from birders who visit the region, including visitors from Canada; and

WHEREAS, 2018 is the centennial of the Migratory Bird Treaty Act, the most powerful and important bird-protection law ever passed, and is recognized internationally as the “Year of the Bird”; and

WHEREAS, the Port of Skagit County has chosen to revise its plans for plantings so as to include Plants for Birds, thus modeling support for Year of the Bird locally;

WHEREAS, we have entered into the season of planning and planting; and


WHEREAS, the Town of La Conner wishes to declare a resolution for The Year of the Bird; **NOW, THEREFORE**,

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE TOWN COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF LA CONNER,

That the Town Council encourages residents and property owners, when making choices of landscaping plantings, to install plants that birds recognize as habitat or food sources; and


