Subject: Caledonia & Maple Intersection

Dear Town Council and Administrators of La Conner:

My name is McKenzie Clark. I have lived on Caledonia street for 3 years. I'm writing to express my concern over pedestrian safety at the Caledonia-Maple intersection. Our family uses the crosswalks at Caledonia & Maple multiple times a day, every day, and it does not feel safe to cross the street when cars are present.

A high percentage of vehicles traveling on Maple do not stop for pedestrians at Caledonia street. Many of the drivers behave like the crosswalk isn't there, or that they don't need to stop. Sometimes we need to wait for every car to pass before we get our turn. Additionally, traffic turning from Caledonia onto Maple often parks across the crosswalk, leaving us to wait or walk around cars. I wonder if Caledonia drivers have trouble seeing Maple traffic through foliage of the corner properties and sidewalk.

I hope that we can come up with a solution that helps protect pedestrians using the Caledonia-Maple intersection. I believe my neighbors, Ivan Carlson and Bill Stokes, have already started a conversation about this issue. I appreciate that dialogue.
